#### 2023-2024 Teen Advisory Board Commitments

Members will typically meet twice a month (except August and December 2023):

One meeting will take place every second Monday of the month at 5:30 pm via zoom.

The second meeting will include a variety of in-person activities and will require travel to the museum or local cultural partners. The location, time, and duration of these meetings will be determined based on the activity and will be communicated no later than a month prior to board members. These meetings will take place in the evenings or weekends.



Applicants must be a high school student in Central Arkansas during the 2023-2024 school term.

Applicants should have interest in the visual and performing arts, film, choir, band or any other type of art.
