Highly recommended to purchase this tool for ease of joining handles to mugs, coil building, and slab building. We only use Bullseye 90 COE (coefficient of expansion) glass in our glass studio; all glass supplies must be purchased through the AMFA Museum Store.

The minimum you can expect to spend during this class is \$85.00 for materials.
